Students will study **academic** and **personal** vocabulary words that directly connect to the standards and texts in each unit we study. Emphasis will be placed on the recognition and use of **academic** vocabulary words to build vocabulary knowledge. Academic vocabulary words are introduced, reinforced and refined throughout each unit and throughout the school year; students will document their progression towards mastery in their **Vocabulary Journal** and **Unit Reflections**.
