Welcome to Math Class! The following information is provided to help you understand what your student will be learning and what is expected of them in the coming year. What will we learn?

The California Common Core standards for 7th grade include Proportional Reasoning, Geometry, Number Sense, Expressions & Equations, and Probability & Statistics. More details about our learning goals can be found by visiting our textbook website: www.cpm.org/cc2

How are we graded?

- Assessment of Standards* 70%
- Classwork and Participation 10%
- Homework 10%
- Final Exam 10%

Students will receive feedback and keep track of their progress on each standard. They will have opportunities to review and re-assess these standards throughout the year. Progress on these standards can be monitored by checking their **Standards Growth Chart. Overall grade and assignment completion can be monitored online through **Jupiter Grades** at login.jupitersed.com. Both students and parents will be provided a login and password for access.*

Student Expectations

- Arrive *on time* with materials each day
- Complete all assignments and tests
- Keep track of own progress and review/re-assess if necessary
- Behave respectfully
- Follow all school rules

A citizenship grade will be given based on these expectations.

Homework

- Homework will be assigned **daily** and will be recorded on their **Math Homework Calendar**.
- Homework assignments should be downloaded from Jupiter Grades and completed using the iPad app called Notability. Students will be trained in this procedure and paper versions will be available as an alternative when needed.
- Students that do not complete the homework on time may be asked to stay after school and complete it.
