The Viking Success Program is a re-teaching program that targets students who are struggling based on in-class assessments. As students take quizzes and tests in class, teachers will assign students to VSP if they do not show mastery of content standards. In short, students will be assigned to VSP if they have low quiz/test scores. In VSP, students will have the opportunity to re-learn skills and concepts, and re-take tests. VSP is a great opportunity for students to master standards and raise their grades!

### Q. How will I know if my student is assigned to VSP?

A. Students will receive a reminder slip the day before VSP. A phone call and email will also be sent home to inform families.

### Q. When is VSP?

A. VSP is after school, from 3:30-5:00pm. The VSP Calendar is available on our school website ([mva.sweetwaterschools.org](http://mva.sweetwaterschools.org))

### Q. Can my student be assigned to VSP more than once for one class?

A. Yes. Referrals are based on assessment scores.

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### Q. What if my student can't stay after school for VSP?

A. Please contact Mrs. Morris. You can either call directly (see number above), leave a message with the Main Office, or send the student with a note.

### Q. What if I want my student to stay for VSP, but he/she isn't assigned?

A. Please feel free to contact your student's teacher if you would like him/her to stay for VSP. The teacher will include your student on the VSP roster.
